You can also print it out and deliver it to them in person and have them mail it to me directly. Please do not wait for your references to turn in your Application. Return your Application promptly. Your references can come in at a later time.

<u>The Application should take you no longer than 10 minutes</u>. Please return it promptly! Once we receive your Application we will contact you to schedule an interview time which will be held in December.

What is Sonshine? A CAMP COMPLETELY ON WATER!

Put 13 students, 2 leaders from a youth group, and 2 Sonshine Staff on a houseboat with skiing, wakeboarding, banana boats, and floaties; add Bible study, sharing, worship, exploring, fishing, sun tanning, swimming, lounging around and enjoying life on the water, and you come up with one of the greatest weeks of your life!

Why Specialized? We are a non-profit / non-denominational Christian resource ministry for churches and have our main office in Lodi, California (between Sacramento and Stockton). We offer a variety of unique houseboat experiences for middle school and high school age groups on the Sacramento River Delta and Lake Shasta. Sonshine began in 1975 when a group of people committed to serving God had the desire to help churches equip their people for ministry. Since then, we've seen the Lord use our ministry to draw thousands of young lives to Him.

What's a typical day like for Campers? Campers wake up to the early morning sun (or get woken up) and notice the beauty and peaceful quiet of being on the water. After breakfast, there is quiet time and Bible study. Bible study can be individual or conducted in small groups. Then it's time for skiing and water recreation. After lunch, the afternoon is filled with skiing, Wakeboarding, swimming, reading, rafting, fishing, sun tanning and exploring. There is also time for good, meaningful conversations. After dinner, there is a night meeting with the whole group. Often this is a time for worship, sharing and perhaps a message from one of the church leaders. After the night meeting, many play group games or talk before it's time to go to sleep! It's a very full, fun day.

So what does the Sonshine Staff do? There are 3 different staff positions.

<u>**Team Barnabas**</u> is a person who ultimately responsible for creating an atmosphere for ministry on the boats. Team Barnabas members quickly pick up the nick name "Barney". It is the "Barneys" job to facilitate keeping the campers fed and the boat clean. The Barney person is also there to help the driver park the boats and get campers ready to ski. The Barney person probably spends the most time on the houseboat with campers engaged in one-on-one and group conversations that may or may not be about Jesus, but definitely have an impact on the campers. Additional "jobs" for the Barney vary from group to group as some may need help with small groups, worship, or something like that. Barneys serve as a volunteer for 3-4 weeks of the summer.

The <u>**Trainee**</u> position is for those who have the desire to be boat drivers. To be a Trainee you must have at least been a Team Barnabas member or be one year out of high school. The Trainee position is a mixture between team Barnabas and the driver position in which they will learn to drive both the house and ski boats while at the same time getting to know campers and helping the youth group in any way needed. During the 5-week volunteer program the trainee will rotate from boat to boat to learn from different drivers. It is essential that trainees are patient, flexible, teachable people who love students and love serving Jesus Christ.

The <u>Driver</u> – officially titled Program Coordinator – does a combination of the two other titles. The driver works the entire summer, usually about 8-10 weeks, driving the houseboat they live on as well as a ski boat shared with another driver. They teach campers to ski, wakeboard, kneeboard and banana. The driver is ultimately responsible for the safety of everyone on both boats and directly communicates with the youth pastor to make sure the program is running smoothly. Drivers meet daily with their trainee and Barneys to pray for their boat and discuss how the week is going. Drivers complete a week of training before campers arrive.
